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## A. Proceedings:

Upon declaration of a quorum, the BAC Chair Dr. Pacoy called the meeting to order with four (4) BAC members attended at 2:15 o'clock in the afternoon. He also acknowledged the presence of all who participated the opening of bid for physically and via online link.

The BAC Chair informed the body that the minutes of the previous meeting of the pre bid conference for the Completion of School of Applied Economics Building, which was sent to the members of the BAC to their respective emails. The BAC Chair asked the BAC members for the motion to suspend the reading of minutes. Dr. Mina motioned & Seconded by Ms. Magandi for the suspension on the reading of minutes & will be proceeded to the opening of bid.

#### **B.** Business Matters:

The BAC Chair emphasized the procedure in determining the prospective bidder's eligibility. He said that the BAC shall use the non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, as stated in the IAEB and the ITB. Any missing document that is required in the bid shall be a ground for disqualification (IRR-A Section 23.2).

The Chair emphasized that a prospective bidder is eligible to bid for the procurement of goods if it complies with the eligibility requirements prescribed for the competitive bidding and should be within the period stated in the invitation to bid. The bidders are required to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contract.

 The Chair declared the opening of the eligibility documents of the bidder. There were two bidders participated in the bidding, MAG Corporation and BQPC Corporation. The results of the bid, to wit:
