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A. Proceedings:

Upon declaration of a quorum, the BAC Chair Dr. PAcoy called the meeting to order with four (4) BAC members attended at 3:15 o'clock in the afternoon. He also acknowledged the presence of all who participated the opening of bid for physically and via online link.

The bidders are required to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contract.
