RESOLUTION NO. 05-2020

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WINNING BIDDERS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF ICT EQUIPMENT FOR ACT for AMIA

Whereas, the ACT for AMIA is an extension service project of the College of Development Management with funding support from the Department of Agriculture for the implementation of climate smart agriculture in the partner barangays of Suawan, Tamugan, and Magsaysay in Marilog District, Davao City;

Whereas, the said project has requested for the procurement of various ICT equipment for use during outdoor training activities as per purchase request number PR # 19-11-232 dated November 26, 2019 and PhilGEPS Reference Number 6736615 dated 5cpt 1,2019, with an approved budget for the contract (ABC) amounting to Twenty-Seven Thousand (P27,000.00) pesos for two units of Voice Recorder, Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred (P18,900.00) pesos for One (1) Terabyte Portable Hard Drive, Sixty-Three Thousand (P63,000.00) pesos for a Portable Sound System, and One Hundred Seventeen Thousand (P117,000.00) pesos for 6,500 ansi lumens Outdoor Projector chargeable to Fund 164-ACT for AMIA;

Whereas, during the January 30, 2020 opening of bids by the CDM Bids and Awards Committee, three suppliers submitted to their bid documents, namely Micro Valley, Gakken Phils. Inc., and Ultrium Corporation with the following price quotations as summarized in the table below:

Whereas, the ACT for AMIA Project has requested for the cancellation of Item 3 as it has found an alternative way of sourcing out the needed Portable Sound System from within the other unit of the College, particularly the Sports Office, that already has recently bought a similar portable sound system;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the results of the above quotations, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee of USEP Mintal Campus **resolved as it is hereby resolved,** to declare **Ultrium Corporation** as having the lowest calculated and most responsive bid for the procurement of two units of **Voice Recorder** and three units of 1 TB **Portable Hard Drive** for use of the ACT for AMIA Project, but to award the purchase of an **Outdoor Projector** to **Gakken Philippines Inc.** that has the most responsive bid for the required higher power of 6,500 ansi lumens.

Resolved further, upon the recommendation of the end user, to cancel the planned purchase of a **Portable Sound System** and to source out the said equipment from the newly purchased similar unit from the CDM Sports Office.

Resolved finally that a copy of this BAC resolution shall be furnished to the College Dean /Head or Representative of Procuring Entity for his information and approval.
