BAC Resolution Declaring LCRB and Recommending Approval

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-23

WHEREAS, the University of Southeastern Philippines advertised the Invitation to Bid for **Supply of Twenty-One (21) Security Guards, USEP, Obrero & Mintal Campus, Davao City, USEP Obrero Campus, Davao City** with a budget allocation of **Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 7,500,000.00)**, and posted the same in PhilGePS on September 26 to October 03, 2018 and in conspicuous places like USEP Main Gate Bulletin Board on the same period;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, five (5) bidders, namely: Axzeen Security Agency, Urduja Security Agency, Blackvolt Security & Service Corporation, Philvets Security, and MINSAS, submitted letter of intent including application for eligibility to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC);

WHEREAS, the bids of the five (5) bidders were received and opened by the BAC on October 29, 2018;

WHEREAS, the detailed evaluation conducted on November 05, 2018 resulted in the following:

WHEREAS, during the bid evaluation and post qualification process, it was determined that Urduja Security Agency was declared not responsive to the procurement at hand due to the following reasons:

1. Urduja Security Services, Inc. was NOT able to submit the required post-qualification documents on time;
2. The Civil Security Group of the Philippine National Police (in Camp Crame, Quezon City) in its letter to BAC dated December 12, 2018 indicated that although the License to Operate (LTO) of the Urduja Security Services, Inc. was authentic, it is however, TEMPORARY because it "was not able to conform to the standards for Renewal of License to Operate (LTO)
3. The Social Security System (SSS)-Large Accounts Division in its reply (dated November 27, 2018) to the TWG's email, verifying the authenticity of the clearance submitted by the bidder, the SSS commented that the submitted certification issued to Urduja Security Services, Inc., was solely for the purpose of renewal of business permit and as stated only valid within 45 days from August 22, 2018, and that it does not serve as clearance for License to Operate, Accreditation & Bidding purposes.


WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded to the post-qualification process for Mati Investigation Security and Allied Services (MISAS), the bidder with the second lowest calculated bid amounting **Php 6,500,425.68** ;

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted to the BAC by MINSAS, its bid was found responsive; hence, determined to be the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB).

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:


- a.) To declare **MINSAS** as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **Supply of Twenty-One (21) Security Guards, USEP, Obrero & Mintal Campus, Davao City.**
- b.) To recommend for approval by the Head of Procuring Entity the foregoing findings.
