About ETEEAP

Expanded Tertiary Education Equivalency and Accreditation Program (ETEEAP) is an educational assessment scheme which recognizes knowledge, skills, and prior learning obtained by an individual from non-formal and informal education experiences.

By establishing equivalency competence standards and a comprehensive assessment system employing written test, interview, skills demonstration, and other creative assessment methodologies, deputized higher education institutions may administer competency based evaluation.

The USeP-ETEEAP shall be the flagship of all higher education institutions offering technological and professional education in harnessing the full potentials of individuals from industry through the nontraditional approach in education.

In pursuance of its mission, and in consonance with the objectives of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), USeP, undertakes its privileged role as one of the deputized Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to implement the Expanded Tertiary Education Equivalency and Accreditation Program (ETEEAP).

The USeP-ETEEAP commits itself to contribute to the development of globally competent teachers, technologists, engineers, foresters, environment resource managers, administrators, and business leaders.

PROCEDURES

1. Secure form and submit application to the USeP ETEEAP Office.
2. Ask for orientation on the documentary requirements, fees, and prescribed accreditation procedure.
3. Pay the admission fees and submit for personal interview and assessment.
4. Pay fees for prescribed courses and submit documents for evaluation.
5. As required, demonstrate skills for assessment and/or attend supplementary courses.
6. Submit for final evaluation.
7. Awarding of degree (as earned).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a. When applicable, endorsement letter from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED).
- b. School credentials, whichever is applicable:
 - High School Diploma
 - Form 137 A
 - PEPT Certificate equivalent to 1st year college
 - Transcript of Records
- c. Certificate of Employment with Job Description from present and past employers
- d. NSO Authenticated Birth Certificate
- e. NBI / Barangay Clearance
- f. Recommendation letter from the immediate superior
- g. Proficiency Certificate, from any of the following:
 - Professional Regulation Commission
 - Professional Organizations
 - Government Regulatory Boards
