GUIDELINES IN SELECTING STUDENTS FOR EDUCATIONAL TOUR ON VIETNAMESE CULTURE AND FOLK DANCE IN TAN TRAO UNIVERSITY, VIETNAM

Eng 32 - Cross-Cultural Communication

- 1. Must be a Filipino citizen.
- 2. AB English student currently enrolled in Eng 22 Cross-cultural Communication
- 3. At least 18 years old as of August 2018.
- 4. In good academic standing as evidenced by his/her GPA (at least 85 or 2.25 and up) and financially capable.
- 5. Is articulate in English
- 6. Has written consent from parents/guardian who must attend briefing/orientation to be scheduled
- 7. Has valid passport at the time of preliminary screening (valid for at least six month from the day of departure)
- 8. Possess students leadership qualities with evidence of good character
- 9. Must learn basic Vietnamese Language
- 10. Must undergo interview with committee who recommends the candidates to the Dean
