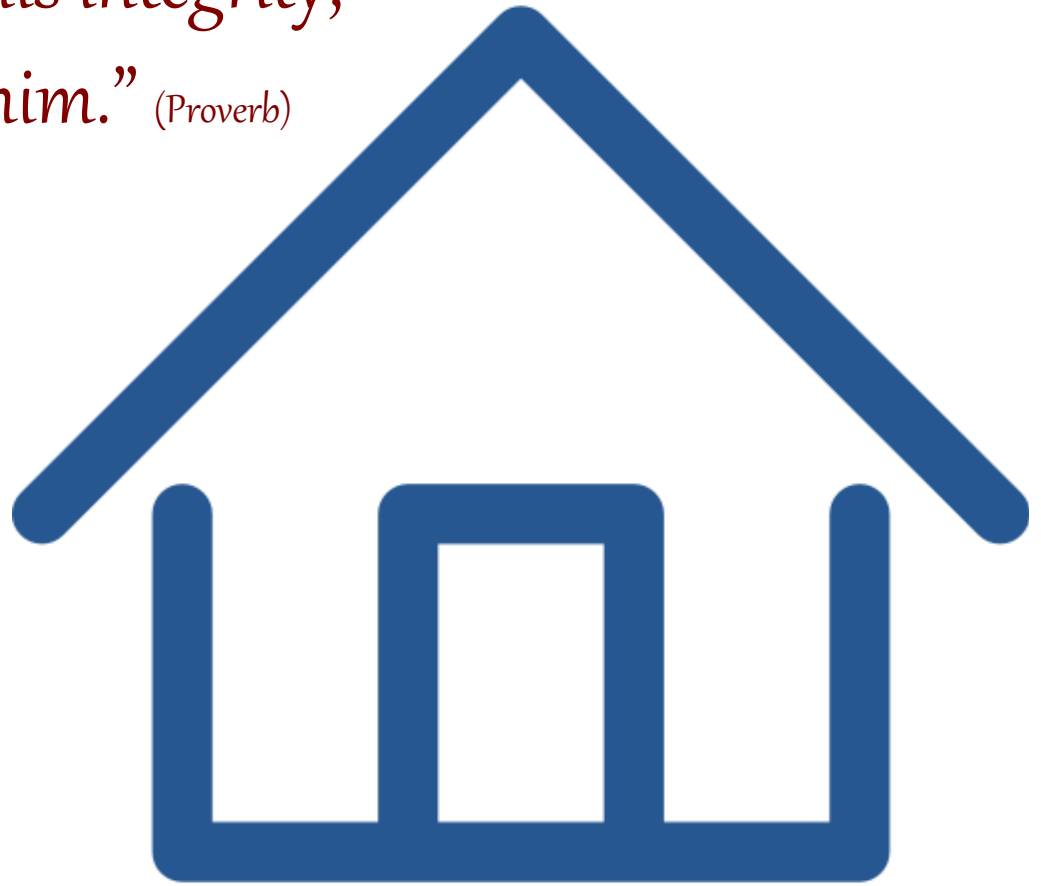

- To give the right precedent for others to follow (accurate foundation must be laid from the very start)

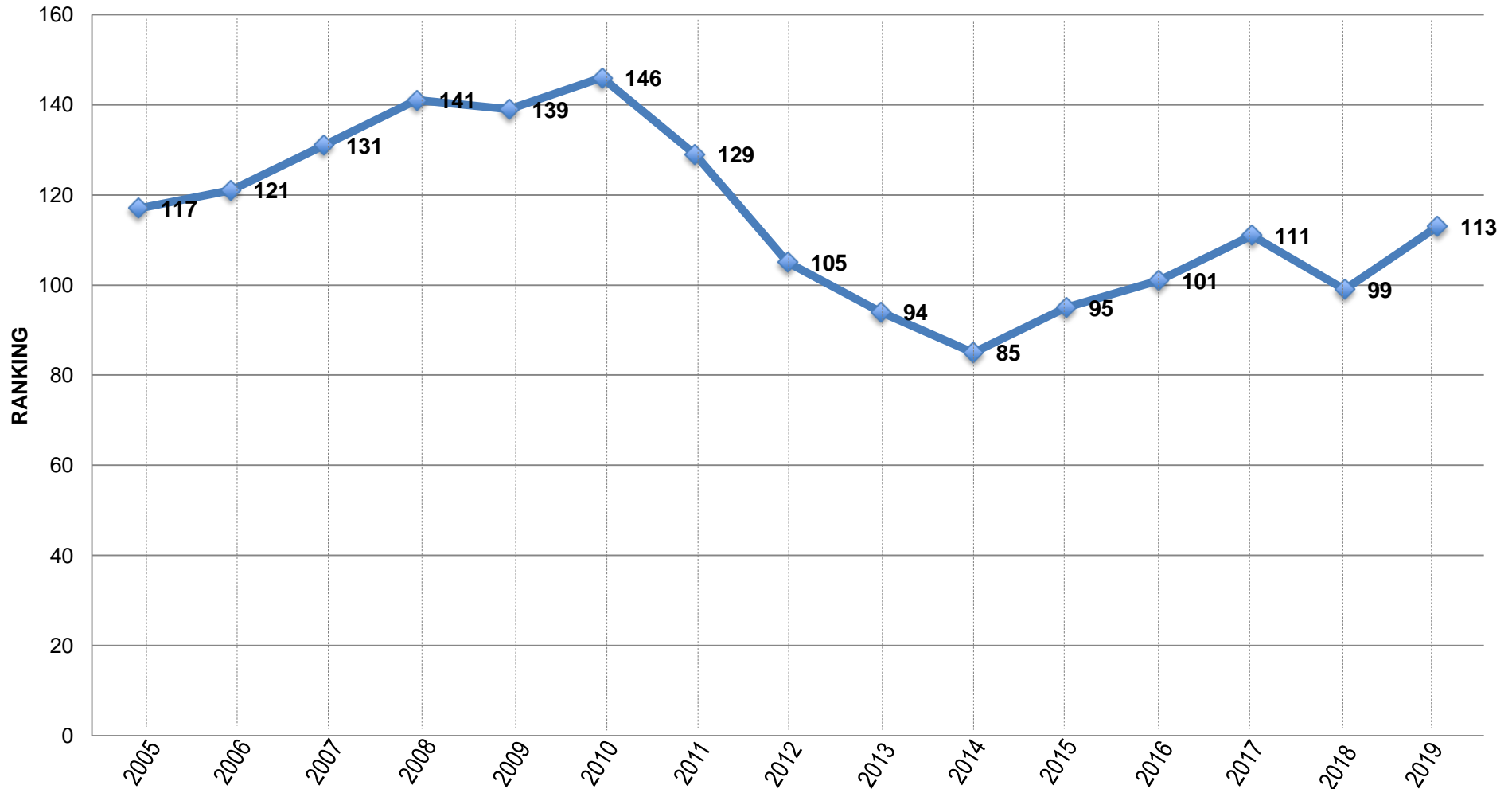

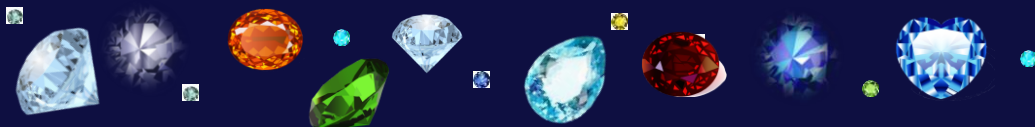

Corruption Perception Index (2005-2019)



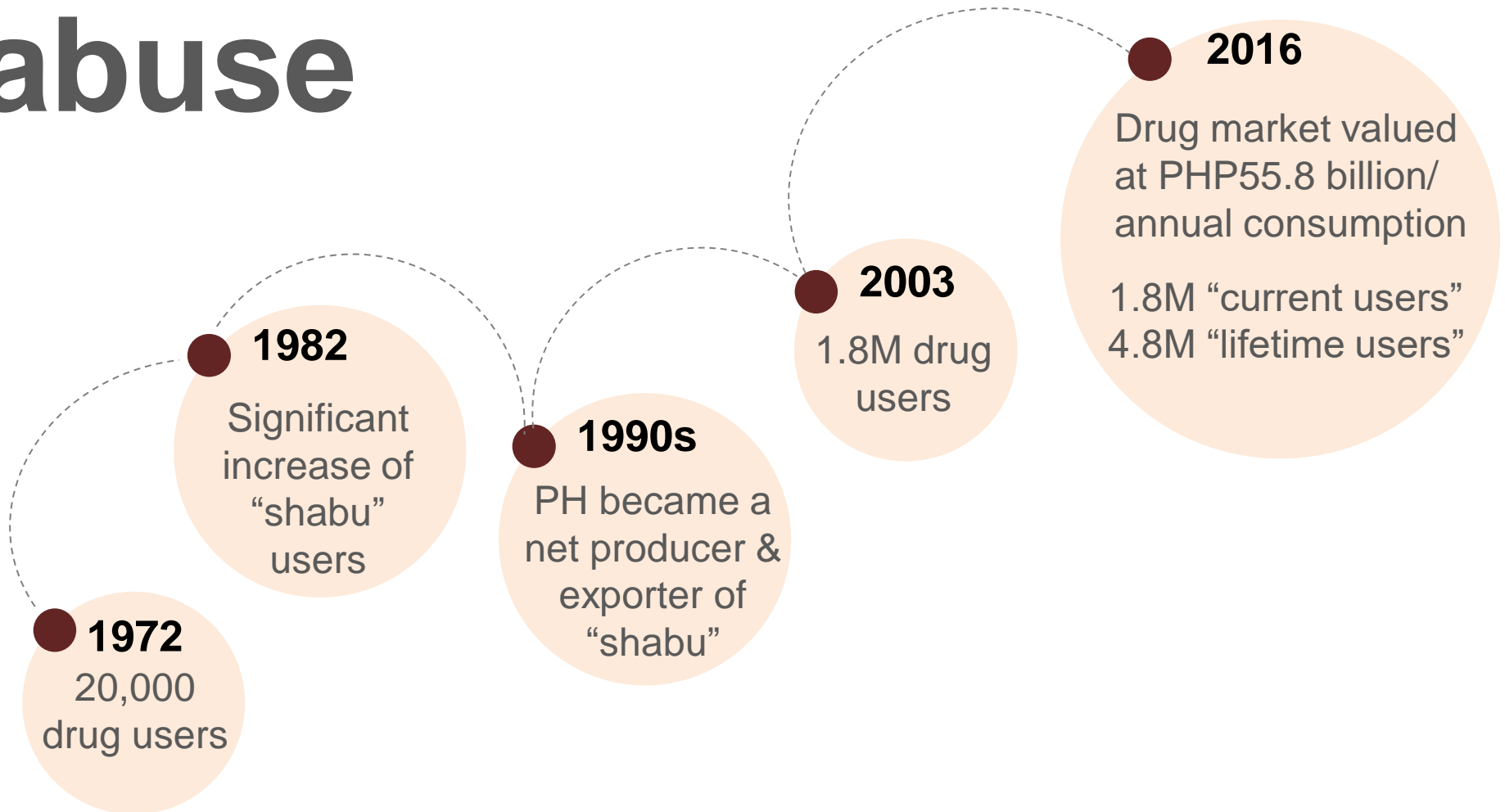

gaming addiction

- 4 in 5 “millennials” (aged between 23 and 28) play online games according to survey by a political consulting firm.
- Top reason for playing games: to reduce stress (37.1%), followed by interaction with friends (22.1%)

- 56.9% of 350 college students spent Php501-1000/week for internet gaming
- 38.6% of 350 college students would spend average of 49 to 72hrs/week; 35.1% for 24 to 48hrs; 8.9% for 72hrs and above

gaming addiction

Spending a significant amount of time in gaming lead to...

“**missed opportunities** and interference with, and displacement of, normal routine and functioning, including basic activities (i.e., sleep, eating, and personal hygiene), real-world social interaction (i.e., talking to people, meeting friends face-to-face, and visiting family), and important responsibilities (i.e., school, work, and care of pets and children)”

- Open the pathway for them.



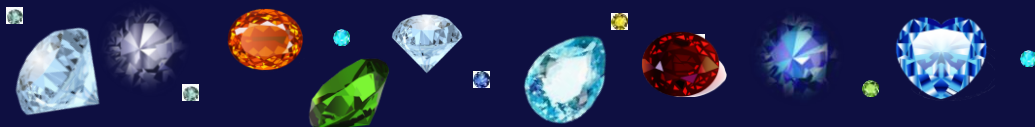
4.2 Future Successor in Office
